# Facilitator Guide & Implementation Overview

**Course**: Implementing the Science of Reading in Early Literacy Instruction

Format: Virtual and In-Person

**Purpose**: This guide supports facilitators and coaches in delivering the course with clarity and consistency, ensuring learners meet instructional goals aligned with the Science of Reading principles.

#### **Session Flow Overview**

Each session includes four core components for both virtual and in-person delivery:

- Welcome & Learning Objectives (5 min)
- Instructional Mini-Lesson (10 min): Multimedia delivery via Articulate 360
- Interactive Application (15-20 min): Guided practice, breakout room discussions (virtual), or partner/small-group tasks (in-person)
- Wrap-Up & Exit Ticket (5 min): Reflection prompts and check for understanding

### **Facilitator Responsibilities**

- Review the facilitator guide and familiarize yourself with multimedia content and pacing tools
- Use the coaching slide deck to introduce strategies clearly
- Guide discussions, monitor understanding, and provide scaffolds as needed
- Administer pre/post assessments and track progress through provided data sheets

### **Coaching and Support Tools**

- Coaching Slide Deck: Supports facilitators in direct instruction and modeling
- Pacing Chart: Provides a suggested timeline for completing each module
- Learner Journal: Used for reflections, vocabulary, and goal-setting throughout the course
- Supplemental Handouts: Printable versions of phonemic awareness charts and decoding checklists
